

Northern Rockies Medical Center participates in a government program which helps us improve healthcare in our community. This program is called 340B and it is here to help uninsured patients.

Here's how it works. The 340B program has been set up to help un-insured patients get their medications at a discounted price.

How can I help? If your medications are on the 340B formulary (list), ask our healthcare team how you can possibly get a discount on your medications with your discount card printed at the Clinic. You then take your prescription to the local Osco pharmacy in Cut Bank, MT.

Who is eligible for discounted prescriptions through 340B? The 340B program serves the uninsured population of our area printing discount cards for uninsured patients to take to the local Osco pharmacy. Depending on the prescription and whether it is on the 340B formulary, discounts may be available on prescriptions as a service to our community by NRMC.
